### PROPOSED 2009 TOWN OF BYRON BUDGET:

•The Town Board discussed the Proposed 2009 Town of Byron budget line item by line item with the following changes being made:

# **General Fund:**

·A1420.4 (Attorney Contractual) – increased to \$10,500 from \$7,500
·A8030.4 (Research Contractual) – increased to \$19,600 from \$14,600
·A1120 (Non-Property Co. Dist) – increased to \$325,000 from \$310,000

### **Highway Fund:**

•DA5130.2 (Machinery Equipment Expense) – Decreased from \$25,000 to \$10,000 due to elimination of a new highway pickup truck

·DA9060.8S (Employees Benefits-Sick Time Accumulation) – Added \$15,000, with an additional \$15,000 to be included in 2010 budget for two retiring highway employees.

·DA2301 (Intergovernmental Charges/Sewer) – increased from \$18,100 to \$26,150 to include Brian Forsyth's benefits

#### Sewer Fund:

·SS9010.8 (Employees Benefits-NYS Retirement) – addition of \$3,500 per bookkeeper.

·SS9060.8 (Employees Benefits-Hospitalization) – increased from \$700 to \$2,600 ·SS9950.9 (Reserve Fund) – addition of \$14,980
